Consideration to Amend ROW Policy

S-005-08

Martin requested allowing brick pavers in the road right-of-way, 8 feet from the edge of the street. Wiegand stated he is in favor of this. Loren questioned what is happening with the asphalt that got put in. Martin stated they are grandfathered in. Shepp questioned why brick pavers should be allowed. Martin stated they allow for infiltration and it is easier to repair small areas as opposed to asphalt. Shepp stated he doesn't have a problem with it but feels the project needs to have city approval before work is done. Wiegand discussed charges for an application fee. Martin stated it is already in the policy. The only change to the policy would be approving brick pavers.

Loren questioned corner lots and allowing them to wrap around the corner. Wiegand suggested limiting it to the size of one car. Hungerman input it may be worthwhile to wrap the corner because traffic is always tearing up the lawns on corner lots.

Maurina came into the meeting at 5:22 p.m.

Maurina questioned if brick pavers really allow drainage. Martin stated the new ones do. Hungerman questioned what happens if they are ruined by the snowplow. Shepp stated it is in the policy already that the City is not responsible for damage done in the road right-of-way.

Loren clarified anything that is there will be grandfather. Martin stated that is correct with the exception of the few residents that have made improvements since the last ROW approval.

Those that do not comply with this new policy will have to be corrected.

Moved by Lorenz, seconded Wiegand, to amend the road right-of-way policy to allow brick pavers 8 feet deep from lot line.
