Jim Kaminski acknowledged he appreciates the difficulties City Hall has in managing the dock list and spaces. He was on the wait list for 12 years. He is embarrassed about his mistake in miss-reading the deadline for the dock renewal. He stated he came in at closing time of the second date(March 13th). He was told at that time the cost was \$665. He didn't have his paperwork with him; he thought he would have more time to get the documents turned in. City Hall expected him in on the following Tuesday. He was out of town and when he got home he received a letter stating he had lost his dock space and his check was returned. He understands why rules are in place and why they need to be enforced. He has seen them abused in the past. He is asking for an exception, option or alternative, rather than going to the bottom of the wait list. He has no place to put his boat now. He would like to waive his space if he knew he can.

Lorenz informed Kaminski this is a study session and no action can take place until the regular meeting next month. He asked if the dock space could be held until council discussed it. Clippert stated the space was already offered to someone else.
