After the agenda item has been introduced and discussed by City Council, the Mayor will ask for public comment on the agenda item. This may be the only opportunity to make public comment on an agenda item. If you wish to make a comment, please raise you hand. When the Mayor recognizes you, state your name for the record and make your comment. City Council will then discuss the item again and offer a motion and decision.
