The public hearing was scheduled to receive public input regarding the proposed application for the 2015 Community Development Block Grant Program.

City Manager Martin explained this is Federal funds which go through Oakland County for the city to use. The funds are intended to help low/moderate income and senior citizen households. This public hearing is to discuss whether the city should approve being in the program. The City has the ability to receive \$5,000.

Martin stated this a reimbursement program. The City does not receive money up front. Martin further explained he is recommending the funds be used for public services, which benefits low to low/moderate income households and senior citizens, with chores such as raking leaves, shoveling snow, tree trimming & removal. He stated applications are available at City Hall.

Mayor Dzenko opened the meeting to the public.
