Public Comment will *only* be taken during this time. When all public comment is heard, the Mayor will state that the meeting is closed to public comment.

**Note:** Because of the amount of business being done and the length of the agenda, it may be necessary for the Mayor to limit public comment, generally three (3) minutes or less.

*In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, any individual with a disability and in need of special assistance should contact City Hall at least one week before the meeting so arrangements can be made. All minutes are available for review at City Hall.*
