Public Comment will *only* be taken during this time. When all public comment is heard, the Chairperson will state that the meeting is closed to public comment.

Note: Because of the amount of business being done and the length of the agenda, it may be necessary for the Chairperson to limit public comment, generally three (3) minutes or less.
