The public hearing was scheduled to receive public input regarding the proposed application for the 2010 Community Development Block Grant Program.

City Manager Martin explained this is Federal funds which go through Oakland County for the city to use. The funds are to help low/moderate income households, by assisting them with home chore and minor home repair requests. This public hearing is to discuss whether the city should approve being in the program. The City has the ability to receive \$8,000.

Martin stated this a reimbursement program. The City does not receive money up front. Martin further explained the funds can be used for such things as public services; yard services, which benefits low to low/moderate income households with chores such as raking leaves, shoveling snow, tree trimming & removal and repairs which helps with larger tasks such as furnace repair/replacement, water heaters, roofs, electrical, plumbing, etc. He stated applications are available at City Hall.

Mayor Lorenz opened the meeting to the public.

There were no public comments from the audience.

Mayor Lorenz closed the Public Hearing at 7:45 p.m.
